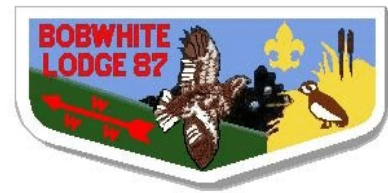

Part III. Rules

As an Arrowman, I understand I, through the lodge leadership, am responsible for the supervision of the event in respect to maintaining discipline and security, and agree to the following **Code of Conduct**:

- (1) I will observe and follow the Scout Oath or Promise, the Scout Law and the Order of the Arrow Obligation.
- (2) I will follow and obey all Boy Scouts of America, Order of the Arrow, Georgia-Carolina, and Knox Scout Reservation rules, regulations, and procedures.
- (3) I will attend all planned general sessions and activities unless I am performing an assigned designated task which precludes me from attending.
- (4) I will be considerate of the camp and other campers by (i) observing quiet hours and lights out from 11:00 p.m. to 7 a.m. in the camping areas; (ii) keeping the camp clean and disposing of trash in the proper place; and (iii) being personally responsible for breakage, damage, or loss of property for which I am responsible outside the normal course of conduct.
- (5) I understand that the purchase, possession, or consumption of alcoholic beverages or illicit drugs at the event will not be permitted and will result in immediate dismissal from the event as well as other penalties. This standard shall apply to all youth and adult participants.
- (6) I understand that I must comply with all federal, state, and local laws, including those which prohibit the use of fireworks, firearms, and gambling. Infraction of these laws and regulations will be cause for immediate dismissal from the event and possible prosecution.
- (7) I will follow the Boy Scouts of America's policy on smoking and observe all smoking restrictions.
- (8) In keeping with National OA Policy, I understand that all individuals **under the age of 18** must remain at the event for its entire duration, unless prior arrangements have been made with lodge leadership, and written consent from a parent/guardian is on file with headquarters, if applicable. All participants, under 18 or over 18 must sign in/sign out when entering or leaving camp.
- (9) **I must provide a copy of a current Class I or higher Medical Form which will be destroyed at the end of the weekend.**
